
ASSISTED SUICIDE LOSES MOMENTUM IN 2017

23 States Defeat Legalization Measures; 1 Court Rejects Legalization



In 2017, 23 states defeated bills to legalize or expand assisted suicide by outright votes, inaction or withdrawal.

New York's highest court unanimously refused to overturn New York's law prohibiting assisted suicide.

Alaska: HB 54 - held in committee without action; Arizona: HB 2336 - died in committee; Connecticut: H.B. No. 6024, HB 6238 - died in committee; Delaware: HB 160 - passed in committee, not scheduled for a House vote; Havaii: SB 1129 - passed in the Senate, held without action in a House committee; Indiana: SB 273, HB 1561 - died in committee; Iowa: Senate File 215, House File 299 - died in committee; Kansas: HB 2120 Death With Dignity Act - died in committee; Maine: LD 1066, LD 347 - passed in the Senate, defeated by House vote; Maryland: SB 354- withdrawn; HB 370 - died in committee; Missouri: Death With Dignity Act HB 524 - attempt to add to another bill failed; Mississippi: Death with Dignity Act Senate Bill 2283 - died in committee; Nebraska: Legislative Bill 450 - died in committee, not a priority bill; Nevada: SB 261 - passed the Senate, died in a House committee; New Mexico: House Bill 171, SB 252 - defeated by Senate vote; New York: S.3151/A.2383, A.3598 - held in committee without action; North Carolina: HB 789 - died in committee; Oklahoma: HJR 109 (Ballot measure) - died in committee; Oregon: SB 893 (allows health care agent to fulfill request for lethal drugs) - died in committee; Rhode Island: House Bill 5468, Senate Bill 224 - died in committee without action; Tennessee: SB 1378, HB 1394 - withdrawn; Utah: HB 76 - tabled in committee; Wyoming: HB 0122 - darfted but not introduced
